All you do is hurt the feelings of the person who thinks they experienced something should you express any scepticism. So miracle stories -- and God conversations -- can be very effective, and have been effective everywhere, for many decades. If you speak against them, you may be held in contempt.

But, once again, this post represents a good appraisal of what the 3ABN viewers formulate in their own minds from watching. And whether God is saying "yes" or "no" I can only formulate my own opinion based on what I have seen and heard.



I've developed a pretty tough skin myself & can take a lot (and you have no idea what goes on at SDAnet *behind* the scenes!). I wasn't complaining for myself. I did, however, see a new member being subjected to some pretty rough treatment for no good reason. (Others who posted in defense of Danny recently *asked* for the way they were treated because they came on as being pretty rough themselves.)

My remarks were intended to provide a bit of a reality check Even on non-Christian boards a distinction is made between argumentation -- which may be quite vigorous -- and ad hominem remarks (put-downs of the person). The latter are technically classified as logical fallacies (invalid arguments) at best and recognized as rudeness or flames by regular posters. This is not allowed on most reputable boards.

Early in the posting history of the 3ABN section you indicated that you realized only one side was being represented, and you seemed eager to have both sides represented. However, the way "country bumpkin" was treated ensures that that side of the matter won't get much exposure here, except by the most thick-skinned folks who may be thick-skinned in more ways than one and maybe not the best "witnesses." Most folks don't willingly subject themselves to such treatment.

But, as you pointed out, it is your call regarding what tone you want to have on this board. If you want to allow flaming of newbies, that's your business. If you want to prevent viewers from posting how they see the issues, that's your business. If you think that ridicule of new posters is an appropriate Christian response, it's your call. But I had thought better of you ...

The way I see it, those who ridiculed "countrybumpkin" weren't trying to be mean to an innocent newbie. They were probably set up for that kind of response by several earlier posters who came on here with both guns blazing, and they failed to recognize that this poster was different. And that makes me think that it would probably be a good idea to be courteous even to those who are discourteous. Would that be so bad for BSDA?

And, of course, I realize I'm here by your good graces and you can shut off my access any time it pleases you. So, if it pleases you to deny my access to this board now, I want to thank you for my time here. I've learned to appreciate the folks here -- even when I don't agree with them. (I also find it interesting to observe the postings of folks I know from other venues by their real identity.) And the fact that you seem to have the most open SDA posting environment on the net has made this a valuable clearinghouse. However, I don't think that treating newcomers a little more kindly would take away from what BSDA has to offer. In fact, I rather think it would add to its attraction. And you would surely get a more balanced picture that way.

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I was speaking to Reflection's concerns over the impact the scandal at 3abn might have on their local church.

I learned early in my SDA experience not to blindly trust our preachers. When I was 17 one of them thought he could take advantage of my youth. This young, good-looking married father of two small children isolated me in a gorgeous valley and tried to do inappropriate things to me but found I was far too savy to become a victim. In contrast, when I took a walk in the woods with HMS Richards SR. a few years later he proved himself to be a faithful man of God whose only agenda was to share his faith with a young woman.

We each must test what is preached to us to see if it is true.

I have never been a fan of Danny's but have found lots of spiritual blessings from 3abn. I was blessed many times by Linda's devotionals on the porch. Of course I only saw them for a short time before she was suddenly gone.

I saw several hours of 3abn programming each day as I did in-home care for my 100-year-old grandmother. She has had a dish since the late 80's and has the programming on every waking hour. She is now $101\ 1/2$ and is still watching it. She is hot-under-the-collar furious with Danny for pushing Linda out and especially for getting remarried.



The letter from Dr. Arild Abrahamsen, dated June 20, 2006, in which he sets forth to refute the

charges of slander brought against himself and Linda Shelton, isn't the first information I have ever received about the stuff going on at 3ABN. I know other people who have been close to this situation. It is an unbelievable mess.

If there is even a shred of truth to the letter written by the doctor then there should be a way to get at what really happened back there at 3ABN. A very clear principle is apparently being ignored. The problem is that this principle is violated over and over again in the Adventist Church. So God waits. But how long will He continue to wait before He acts with merciful precision and terrifying certainty? When there is serious conflict in any church setting, all the parties involved should be given a "time out" until the issues and conflicts are cleared up completely or exposed for what they really are. This encourages the parties who are in conflict to see exactly how serious this matter is to the entire church. (Consider, by way of example, 2 Thess. 3:14-15; 1 Cor. 5:9-11). If the parties will not cooperate then whatever ministries they are the head of, or involved in, need to come to an end or their personal involvement with that particular ministry must be terminated. Since there seems to be no possible way to bring this kind of pressure on Danny then all individuals who use 3ABN should immediately stop putting programs on the air and should immediately stop attempting to get 3ABN on the air in any venue or location. They should begin a fasting and prayer vigil, pleading with God to do whatever He must do to bring the full truth of this dispute out into the True Light. They should confess and deal with the sins in their own lives so God can work uninhibited. The administrations of the Local Conference, Union Conference and Division need to convene a board of inquiry. This board must be made up of only those people who have no vested interest or conflict of interest with 3ABN. (If it is true that the local Conference President sits on the governing board at 3ABN and that his own parents actually work for 3ABN then I wonder if he ever stopped to think that he has created a huge conflict-of-interest for himself? How is he able to sit on the very board that hires and fires his own constituents? There is no possible way anyone can say that this is exactly the same situation as individuals being hired and fired from the Local Conference. The constituents of the Conference should insist that he immediately resign as Conference President or resign from the 3ABN board). Danny should be told that, until such time this board can hear and decide on this matter the world wide church cannot support 3ABN or use 3ABN for any purpose including any and all public evangelism. He should be told they will not promote it anywhere. (There is one huge item which has been grossly overlooked in all of the charges and character assassination that has taken place. Linda would almost certainly welcome, with open arms, a fair, unbiased hearing to clear the air on this entire matter). Further, they should go to their constituents and acquaintances, whoever they are, and plead with them to stop watching or promoting 3ABN immediately. With nothing more than hearsay as charges against Linda, Danny's feet appear to be in a big, big fire, especially given the fact that nobody has ever caught Linda and the doctor in any compromised situation. To my understanding Danny doesn't even have a charge of literal adultery against her with clear evidence to back up such a charge. But he, Danny, has already gone off and remarried. Can't we see that the Bible addresses such issues? If the local church refuses to deal with this then where is the leadership at the Local Conference level? If the Local Conference refuses to deal with it then where is the leadership at the Union Conference, and so on up the line? We claim we are situated on the brink of the Second Coming. We think of ourselves as virtually standing on the boarders of the Heavenly Cana. If Israel had refused to deal with the Achan situation they would have been stuck at the ruins of Jericho. Why do we fail to see the parallel here? Yet unbelievably leaders are saying, "It just isn't our jurisdiction because 3ABN is not a denominationally owned entity." Question; where is 3ABN located? Question; at what churches are Danny and Linda members? Question; where are these churches located? Question; what entity/ies has/have jurisdiction over these churches? Question; what entity has jurisdiction over those lower entities, and so on up the line? Question; does the organized Seventh-day Adventist Church still use and promote 3ABN as though it is a legitimate Seventh-day Adventist organization? What about the upcoming series of meetings? Finally, how long will we remain stranded at the boarders?

Now I hear that Danny affectionately speaks of his "new wife" right on the air by asking the viewers this rhetorical question: "Isn't she just the most beautiful thing you have ever seen?" It seems like only a short time ago he was saying very similar things about Linda! Wow! Do we honestly think this ministry is not tainted? A black cloud hangs over it. Who wants to let its darkness blind them? People think they, personally, are innocent yet they continue to use 3ABN to promote their ministries, all the while claiming that these ministries are the Lord's. Others, not just individuals but also entire

churches continue to pour millions of dollars into 3ABN. Others continue to promote 3ABN and continue to try to get it on the air in their location so that its ministry can "bless" and "help" the local church "win" new converts! (When the new converts finally discover the black cloud what kind of geriatrics will the local church have to go through to "fix" the situation – and what too about the Local Conference and Etc.)?

People fail to see there is something very seriously wrong at 3ABN. By continuing to use this organization, they also fail to see that they have become party to its specific sins. Why? Because, it is a ministry that supposedly belongs to God and they themselves also claim to belong to God, all within the same remnant church! Why do they become party to its sins? Because, what they fail to cure, especially when God has outlined a way for them to cure it, they become party to themselves. How can a house divided against itself, continue to stand? This cannot be within God's kingdom. We claim to be preparing for heaven and the new earth, yet we know full well such behavior will not be allowed there. Those who carry on in this way or allow such behavior will not enter or else they will have to repent and be changed before they get there. So we see the need for prayer, fasting, confessing and pleading with God; and the need to place demands upon Danny and 3ABN. None of this is easy or pleasant.

This is not the way things should be. Money, power and influence, often hold sway over truth. There is a term for this. It's called politics. Sadly, there is a very good chance the steps outlined above will never be carried out. Such steps are just too drastic. As is often the case, the stench is rising and spreading everywhere. If we do nothing, eventually it will permeate heaven itself and God will take the reigns into His own hands. Because of the moral weakness and political corruption on the part of some of God's professed people, countless thousands, and in this case possibly hundreds of thousands may be seriously injured or possibly even destroyed. Such needless waste and destruction happens because we didn't have enough fortitude to take a stand at the beginning and deal with the problem in spite of the initial fallout. All along the way there are increasing levels of fallout, but all along the way God is testing each of us to see if we will now take a stand against what is wrong. Even though the hour is very late and the loss and destruction gets increasingly greater with each passing moment yet He still tests us to see if now we will finally stand. As time passes and the stakes get higher the fallout and loss becomes greater. Finally, because we failed to act, we ourselves get caught in the falling rubble of the building. We discover that now we too are suffering great loss because of our failure to take a stand. We discover that the part of the house divided did not stand. God swept it away and nothing is left.

Until this thing is cleared up I don't see how anyone can, with a clear conscience, have any connection what-so-ever with 3ABN.

'B, Even from the beginning 3abn has positioned itself as being the judge of the church rather than as he helper of the church. At times the influences Johann mentions above have been less, and sometimes more, but they have always been there. If you will read the "Unauthorized History" threads carefully you will find references to some of this..... though here, as in every other area, all of us who are posting have been very selective and sparse in detail.

As an aid to finding specific information I constructed a "Guided Tour" to the history threads and Calvin posted it as an additional post in the thread in the Pinned section, which Clay had begun earlier. Since that has brief notations on it, you can scan down that one post to find specific topics. In this case look for references to Kenny Shelton, since he is the Shelton brother who was defrocked by the Adventist church because of the way he was doing exactly what Johann described above (as well as being closely linked with other "Independent Ministries" of like mind). But even though his Adventist credentials were removed, Kenny remained as pastor of his "offshoot" church, and was also on the buts with Danny for several years. As of last August, he returned to 3abn and is now being featured prominently as one of their speakers..... as well as traveling on some of their promotional tours. Both Beartrap and Sister posted specifically and descriptively of this, and perhaps others added to it. This is not to say that Kenny is the only one there who is of this ilk. But if you find posts about him, you will ikely find others that bear on these concerns in the same general vicinity.

As to the present concerns that have been expressed that 3abn would be taken over..... or given over..... to one or more of the non-Adventist persons who hold high positions there (or to those who have but a thin veneer of Adventist doctrine on top of their previous Charismatic/Pentecostal belief systems) thus gradually taking it further away from being truly "Adventist"..... these have also been voiced in the History threads as well as elsewhere on this site. Look especially for references to Mollie Steensen and Shelly Quinn. It would also be well for you to examine the 3ABN website (newly lesigned early summer 2005) and note that they do not identify themselves as a supporting ministry of the Adventist church. They don't even identify themselves as an "Independent Ministry" of the Adventist church.

They plainly state there that. "3ABN is not owned, operated or funded by any church, denomination or organization, so people from all cultures and backgrounds appreciate 3ABN programming. Many of 3ABN's employees and volunteers are members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church."

As you read the Unauthorized History threads, also note what has been said about the Pentecostal nfluences at 3ABN.... not only now, but from the very beginning. Adventists were largely ignorant of he facts that there were so many Pentecostals even former Pentecostal ministers.... who have exerted a great deal of influence on the thought patterns taught by 3ABN employees.

And on the other hand.... look for those things which give some glimpses of the contentions between 3ABN and Adventist church leaders. Some of those you will also find in the "Guided Tour"... in some cases as links to specific posts in other threads.

The letter from Dr. Arild Abrahamsen, dated June 20, 2006, in which he sets forth to refute the charges of slander brought against himself and Linda Shelton, isn't the first information I have ever received about the stuff going on at 3ABN. I know other people who have been close to this situation. It is an unbelievable mess.

If there is even a shred of truth to the letter written by the doctor then there should be a way to get at what really happened back there at 3ABN. A very clear principle is apparently being ignored. The problem is that this principle is violated over and over again in the Adventist Church. So God waits. But how long will He continue to wait before He acts with merciful precision and terrifying certainty? When there is serious conflict in any church setting, all the parties involved should be given a "time out" until the issues and conflicts are cleared up completely or exposed for what they really are. This encourages the parties who are in conflict to see exactly how serious this matter is to the entire church. (Consider, by way of example, 2 Thess. 3:14-15; 1 Cor. 5:9-11). If the parties will not cooperate then whatever ministries they are the head of, or involved in, need to come to an end or their personal involvement with that particular ministry must be terminated. Since there seems to be no possible way to bring this kind of pressure on Danny then all individuals who use 3ABN should immediately stop putting programs on the air and should immediately stop attempting to get 3ABN on the air in any venue or location. They should begin a fasting and prayer vigil, pleading with God to do whatever He must do to bring the full truth of this dispute out into the True Light. They should confess and deal with the sins in their own lives so God can work uninhibited. The administrations of the Local

Conference, Union Conference and Division need to convene a board of inquiry. This board must be made up of only those people who have no vested interest or conflict of interest with 3ABN. (If it is true that the local Conference President sits on the governing board at 3ABN and that his own parents actually work for 3ABN then I wonder if he ever stopped to think that he has created a huge conflict-of-interest for himself? How is he able to sit on the very board that hires and fires his own constituents? There is no possible way anyone can say that this is exactly the same situation as individuals being hired and fired from the Local Conference. The constituents of the Conference should insist that he immediately resign as Conference President or resign from the 3ABN board). Danny should be told that, until such time this board can hear and decide on this matter the world wide church cannot support 3ABN or use 3ABN for any purpose including any and all public evangelism. He should be told they will not promote it anywhere. (There is one huge item which has been grossly overlooked in all of the charges and character assassination that has taken place. All along the way there are increasing levels of fallout, but all along the way God is testing each of us to see if we will now take a stand against what is wrong. Even though the hour is very late and the loss and destruction gets increasingly greater with each passing moment yet He still tests us to see if now we will finally stand.
