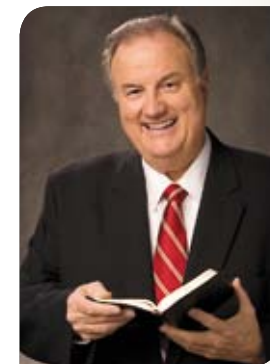

# THE GOD OF SECOND CHANCES

**H**e was a pastor's kid—and life was not easy. The expectations of others were constantly pressuring young Jorge Jaque to behave a certain way, but he wasn't having any of it, now that he was twelve.

Although his family was not wealthy, the decision to send Jorge to a boarding school became urgent as he began making friends with kids who were using drugs.

"I never used drugs, but my parents thought it was a good idea to send me to boarding school right away. That turned out to be both good and bad," he adds. "On the one hand I became independent, but I also lost my sense of belonging, so I felt a tremendous need to explore the world."

"My father had always wanted one of his boys to enter the ministry, but when I finished high school I wanted to take anthropology and archeology, instead. Obviously this decision was not welcomed by my father.

"I decided to study theology for a year, but the year wasn't up before I wanted to put some distance between my home country and me," Jorge says. "So I moved back to Argentina, and although in my heart I really didn't want

"I was born in Temuco, Chile, to a family of three children," he begins. "My dad was a colporteur, selling Christian books door to door. When I was three we moved to Argentina, where we lived until my dad was called back to Chile to be a pastor.

"My mother barely finished high school, but she was one of the wisest people I've ever known. She was very unassuming, and not one to waste words. But while she always showed a genuine interest in people, she also analyzed them carefully."

to be a minister, I continued studying theology and philosophy at the Adventist college."

But his focus changed dramatically when he met a girl.

"I was 21, and she was 19, and we were soon married for all the wrong reasons," he admits. "We were just kids, and our relationship got off to a difficult start."

But then something at graduation made a lasting impression on him. "Our class motto was, 'Lord, what do You want me to do?' That phrase haunted me for many years. Although I'd done what my dad wanted, and I was trying to do what I thought God wanted, I was never satisfied.

"My immaturity took me to São Paulo, Brazil, where I

worked at a friend's carpet cleaning business. I was living for the moment, but I kept wondering, *What am I doing here in Brazil?*"

Eventually Jorge moved back to Argentina, where his interest in photography landed him a job in the audio-visual department at a church conference office. "I thought I'd be working with photography, but instead they put me in the print shop!" he says. "I had ink up to my elbows, and kept wondering, *What am I doing here?*"

"The AV department produced materials for Sabbath school, including slide presentations. One day I told my boss I thought we could improve on the lighting, and he recom-

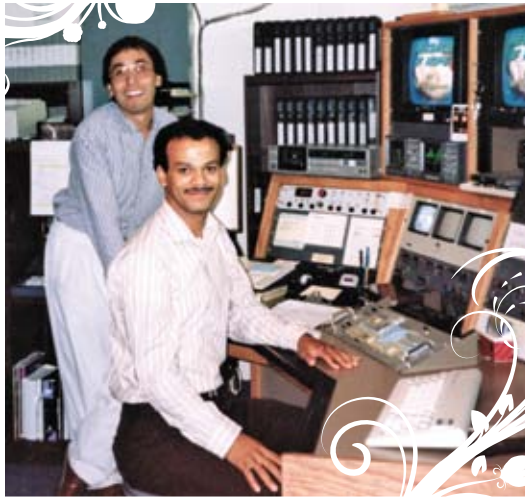

mended I take some courses. After two years of classes and workshops, I got the job as director of the photography department. My fascination with 35 mm film also took me to film school, where I learned proper techniques for shooting, editing, and producing film.

“Then the South American Division of Seventh-day Adventists asked if we would prepare the 1985 General Conference report on film. We wrote a script detailing the work of the church in South America, and even recreated some Bible times,” he says. “We traveled throughout the continent with a crew of four—all the way to the Amazon jungle.”

Jorge first heard of 3ABN in 1989 when he was helping to organize a huge South American Youth Congress in Buenos Aires,

Argentina. A pastor friend had said he thought 3ABN might be interested in covering the event.

“I remember seeing the 3ABN team with all their equipment arrive,” Jorge says. “They had three cameras, editing equipment, a switcher, and so many other machines—it was unbelievable. It was also my first video production—ever! We hired camera people, built stands for the cameras, and found a vehicle that served as a production truck. Before it was over, Gonzalo Santos asked me if I’d be interested in coming to 3ABN to learn more about video production.

“I was stunned. *Was he serious?* At the time my marriage was in chaos, but with my wife’s permission, I applied for a training visa, and made the long trip from Argentina to the United States. When I walked into 3ABN’s studio, all I could think was, *Wow!* The crew taught me the basics of editing, lighting, and camera work, but although I could read English, I had a hard time with the southern Illinoisan accent. In fact, I didn’t understand a single word Danny Shelton said!”

A month later his wife arrived, but it wasn’t long before she tired of her surroundings. “I was learning so much, but my wife was bored,” Jorge recalls.

“She was used to the city, and West Frankfort wasn’t quite big enough.”

After four months, the situation had become unbearable. Jorge’s brother lived in Walla Walla, Washington, and had invited them to come study English. Now Jorge’s wife was eager to leave—with or without him—so, with a heavy heart, he finally said goodbye to 3ABN.

Later on that year they visited San Diego, California, and Jorge fell in love with that city. “I didn’t have a work permit, so I couldn’t get a job there, but the pastor of a Spanish church put me to work producing their worship services on video, eventually extending a formal invitation for me to work part-time as an assistant pastor. Although the job was only temporary, it allowed me to apply for permanent residency. Still I wondered, *Lord, is this what You want me to do?*”

After trying, unsuccessfully, to obtain a full-time position as pastor, Jorge eventually got a job selling cemetery plots. “I did so well, I became a team leader—traveling all over, and enjoying the business life. I eventually changed positions and began working as a family services counselor with this company.

“My marriage finally disintegrated, and the stresses of my job were getting to me. Every day I

dealt with the tragic deaths of children, suicide, and worse. I found myself seeking relief by hanging out with my coworkers, and I started drinking. In no time, I knew all the bars from Oceanside to Tijuana. It was noisy fun and all the dating kept me distracted, but it was really a painful, lonely life.”

A nephew from Walla Walla offered him a good job in the mortgage business, but Jorge

soon discovered that if cemetery counselors in southern California liked to drink, the mortgage people in Washington State were even worse! “I wasted my money on \$90 bottles of wine, but the loneliness wouldn’t go away.”

Through the years Jorge stayed in touch with his old 3ABN friend, John Dinzey. “John would tell me how 3ABN Latino was growing, and sometimes I’d watch the credits just to see if I still knew anybody there. But my life had changed, and I had no hopes of coming back.

“Another nephew from Argentina came to live with me

for a few months. He decided that what I needed was a good Christian lady, so he signed me up with a Christian singles website. I wasn't at all interested, because it seemed so weird," he adds, "but I filled out my profile information anyway. Women started writing and calling me, but they all lived too far away, so eventually I cancelled my subscription.

"Around that time, I felt a strong desire to go back to church, so one Sabbath I attended an afternoon concert, and heard the testimony of Cuban-born violinist, Jaime Jorge.

"Suddenly, without warning, the Holy Spirit really tugged on my heart," he recalls. "I was running from God, so I stayed

drunk all week during a business trip, coming back exhausted. *Lord, I'm so alone*, I thought as I sat parked in my parking lot. *I need You, but I also need someone special in my life.*

"When I turned on my computer I found an e-mail from the dating service, inviting me to sign up again for 10 free days. When I did I was surprised to find a beautiful girl who lived nearby. Her name was Lynette, and before long we were chatting online like old friends. I thought she was kinda cute, and definitely too young for me. But before long, we met, and not long after that she insisted I meet her mother," Jorge says with a smile. "Four months later we were married!"

A huge miracle took place in Jorge's life. "From one day to the next, I stopped drinking," he says. "I saw my relationship with Lynette as an answer from God, and although I believe I was an alcoholic, after I met her, I was never seriously tempted again. It's so obvious that the Holy Spirit took the desire to drink from me.

"When I met my wife, she was a very devoted Christian," he continues. "We began attending the very friendly Riverview Seventh-day Adventist Church in Pasco, Washington. One day I mentioned my idea of setting up a video ministry to my pastor. He liked it, but I'd been out of that business so long I thought I'd better call my old friend, John Dinzey, at 3ABN.

"We talked about my dilemma, and he promised to send me some information. Then he added, 'Jorge, it's interesting you called, because I'd like to ask you about someone you know. We're considering him for the position of production manager.'

"I gave him a positive recommendation, and John promised to be in touch in a few weeks. When we spoke again a month later, he told me the man had turned down the job. And then he dropped a bomb!

"Jorge, are you interested in that position?' he asked.

"I was speechless. *Lord, what do you want me to do?* I wasn't looking for a job; I was happy with the one I had.

"If I had to give you an answer, I could only say yes,'

I replied. 'You know the only reason I'm here in the United States is because I wanted to be at 3ABN.'

Jorge pauses for a moment. "I get emotional when I think of this," he explains. "My thoughts were, *If this is from God, the pay cut should not bother me or my wife, and she will be 100 percent behind this move.* After the interview we added up all our bills, and decided to come! Some might have thought we were completely mad, but to us it was a chance of a lifetime.

"It wasn't easy to leave Washington," he adds. "Lynette's brother was sick with cancer, and her mother had just moved in across the street from us. But we knew it was God's invitation. You see, I was finally coming back to where God had brought me 18 years ago. And that's amazing to me!" ■

# Network, or a Station?

**T**his month I would like to clear up the confusion about the 3ABN Radio Network and 3ABN Radio affiliate stations. (I know—some of that is our own doing!) When you hear us refer to “our” stations, or when we say things like, “We have a station here or there,” it can be confusing. Let’s just say that we consider all of our affiliates part of *our family*, so sometimes we innocently refer to them as “ours.”

3ABN Radio Network is located in southern Illinois, where our programming is generated. Jay Christian, our

production and programming manager, selects the programs from our computer database, puts them in the correct time slots, and sends them to an automated computer system. Pam Clark, our clerical assistant, fills the time between programs with announcements and promos, which include spiritual thoughts from a variety of sources. The result is a well-balanced broadcast of programs available 24/7.

Here’s the condensed version of how our signal gets to you: We transmit our programming to the satellite from our 3ABN Master Control facility. Then

the widgets, gizmos, and transponders send the signal back to earth. (Now you know why I worked in 3ABN television engineering for only three months!) Next, a 3ABN Radio affiliate station converts the satellite signal to an AM or FM frequency, then broadcasts it to their coverage area via an antenna. Finally, listeners in that coverage area tune in to that specific frequency to listen to our Christ-centered programming!

You should know that the radio stations we refer to as “our stations” are really “our affiliates.” Each affiliate station is owned and operated by an individual person or separate corporation that has chosen to use our programming. 3ABN Radio does not own these stations, with the exception of WBLC, 1360 AM, in Lenoir City, Tennessee, and WDQN, 95.9 FM, in Du Quoin, Illinois.

A list of 3ABN Radio affiliates can be found on our website, [www.3abnradio.org](http://www.3abnradio.org). If you live within a short distance of any of those cities, you can tune your radio to those frequencies to enjoy 3ABN Radio programming. If you don’t live within the coverage area of an affiliate in one of the listed cities, you won’t be able to hear our programming on a broadcast frequency. But there are other

options! You can get a satellite dish and receiver for your home use, or listen through our Internet website on your computer. In fact, if you have a Windows Media compatible “smartphone” or PDA with Internet capability, you can even listen on that!

Another option is to contact a local radio station in your area and ask if they’re interested in new, Christian network programming at no charge. Invite them to visit our website and check out our live broadcast to help them decide. They can always contact us to ask questions, get more information, and work out the details.

God’s undiluted message rains down on all the inhabited continents of the earth from several satellites used by 3ABN Radio. We’re diligently working to find radio stations around the world that are willing to use their frequencies to reach lost souls everywhere.

The inspired writer Ellen White wrote this in her book, *My Life Today*: “This message will close with power and strength far exceeding the midnight cry.” (See Matthew 25:6.)

The Bible promises, “After these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory.” Revelation 18:1. ■

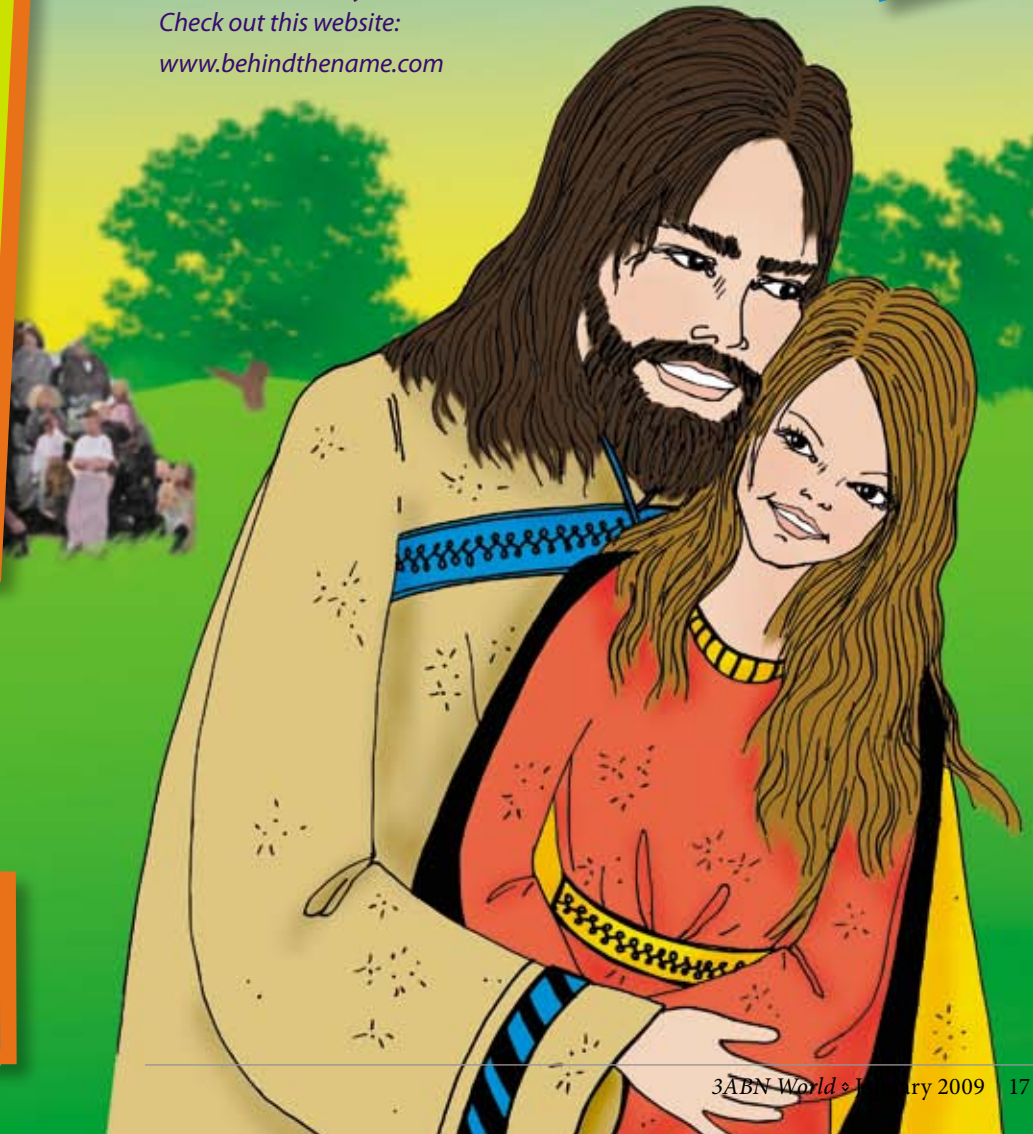

# NEVER AGAIN

*After being deceived by a false prophet, they didn't want to make a mistake again*

The tension level was high as Ron and Caitlin Layton waited for news of the impending disaster. As seconds and minutes ticked away on July 4, 2003, their hearts beat faster and faster. Striving for self-

the end. They'd heard and followed the teachings of a man who'd predicted the destruction of America by France, and they believed that on that very day the United Nations would force everyone to worship Pope John Paul II, whom he called the antichrist.

"My father and I had listened to him on shortwave radio for seven or eight years," Caitlin says. "I'd been raised attending church every Sunday, but my dad had become convinced that the pre-tribulation "secret rapture" was not true. Then he became convinced of God's seventh-day Sabbath, but unfortunately, only part of what we

heard was true. There were a lot of lies mixed in as well."

As the years went by, the predictions had become more dire—first about Y2K, and then the end of America in 2003. As he urged his listeners to stock up on "survival" food, the preacher reminded them they could buy it from his ministry—at an inflated price, of course. After selling everything she owned, Caitlin heeded his call to get out of the city and head for the hills, where she met Ron.

"I was a bit apprehensive about giving everything up when I left for Montana," he admits. "I figured that if this was indeed the end, I wouldn't miss

anything. But if not, I would have to start all over again."

Despite their apprehension, the two fell in love and were soon married. Now they joined the small band of believers as they studied, waited, and worried.

*What if it doesn't happen?* Caitlin wondered. *I'll call my mom and tell her I love her because I'll never talk to her again!*

"There was a lot of tension in our group," she says, "and we were really scared—especially of how people outside our group would react to the disaster. Perhaps the rest of the population would go crazy and destroy everything in their path."

When the Fourth of July came, they listened to the radio, anxiously awaiting the dreaded news.

“The preacher had said that if his prediction didn’t come true, then we should consider him a false prophet and abandon him,” Caitlin says. “But sadly, most of them didn’t take his advice.”

Ron was disappointed, too. “I was very upset that this so-

take, and because that admission required so much humility, we didn’t have much room for anger! We left the ranch and lived in our old Chevy van for about three months, and when we tried contacting the others, we found ourselves shunned!

“I remember reading about William Miller back in the 1800s. He preached the eminent Second Coming of Christ in 1844, and his followers were so sure of it, that they let their crops rot in the field. I knew how they felt! We were so humiliated. Our credibility was shot. But that just drove us to the Bible more. Never again would we be deceived. I’d always believed God had His remnant people, and that one day He would lead us to them.”

Without an address or a telephone, Ron and Caitlin found it next to impossible to find a job. “We had no food and no money,” she says. “One day I was in a truck stop on the phone with my dad, asking him to sell my laptop and send us the money. A trucker overheard my conversation, and insisted on giving us \$80! It was so difficult to accept it, but I recognized this was God’s way of helping us. That money sustained us for a long time.

“Once, when we were tired of eating beans and rice, we

called prophet had led us on, but what really unsettled me was the realization that my wife and I were in the predicament of having no job, no home, and no money! One good thing came out of that experience, however. I realized that the only thing we could trust was God’s Word, and that we both needed a deeper understanding of it.”

“I experienced a lot of anger,” Caitlin says, “but mostly at myself. I prayed for God to remove my resentment because I had enough to deal with—and I didn’t need that extra burden! Ron and I took responsibility for ourselves. We’d made a mis-

spent our last few dollars on a restaurant meal. We wondered out loud whether to buy two plates, but finally decided on splitting one, so we could have a few dollars left over. Apparently a lady overheard us, because when I asked for the check, the waitress informed me our meal had been paid for by the lady who had just left.

“Looking back, we knew that even though we didn’t have a job or a place to go, God had promised in Jeremiah 29:11 to prosper us, and not harm us. We knew that promise applied to us, too.”

Slowly, God put Ron and Caitlin back on their feet. “Now

we have great jobs, a place to live, and a newer car; I know it’s all because we trusted God. When the world really does collapse, we won’t be shocked because we’ve expected it for so long, and have been in that situation before. We’ve put it all on the altar for the Lord, and we can do it again when He calls for us to do so.”

In May of 2006, while Ron traveled to New York to see his mother before she passed away from cancer, Caitlin began visiting different churches in search of strength through this difficult time. “But I kept finding fault with them,” she says.

*Finally after two years of studying, Ron and Caitlin were convinced. Pastor Justin Aguilar was privileged to baptize them and welcome them into the Seventh-day Adventist Church.*

Eventually I thought, “I’m too picky, and I was despairing of ever finding a church that believed in the whole Bible—and all ten of God’s Commandments. So I prayed that He would lead me to a church that worshipped on Saturday.”

Not long afterwards, Ron met someone in a store parking lot who gave him a book. As it turns out, a group of Seventh-day Adventist Church members were passing out free copies of *Ten Commandments Twice Removed*.

“When I glanced through the book I was very surprised,” he says. “I’d never heard of the Seventh-day Adventist Church, and I had been a believer in the

Saturday Sabbath for a long time. But I was still on my guard due to past experiences.”

Inside the book they also found an invitation to attend 3ABN’s *Ten Commandments Weekend* which was being shown at their local Seventh-day Adventist church. “That night Pastor Doug Batchelor was talking about the Fourth Commandment, and we could hardly believe it—after all those years, we finally found a church that kept the Sabbath!” Caitlin says.

“Of course we had lots of questions, especially about Ellen G. White and the gift of prophecy. You see, we’d already been deceived by a man’s prophetic visions, so when we heard that she also had visions from the Lord, we were naturally skeptical. But the church members were so kind and understanding. They saw that we were actively seeking the truth.

“I began having trouble at work because they asked me to work on Saturdays. I was also having a serious health issue. The doctors couldn’t seem to help me, so I prayed about it, and the Lord impressed me to stop working on His Sabbath. When I finally told my boss I couldn’t do it anymore, he let me have Sabbaths off. Amazingly, my health issue was resolved, too!”

Although it took them several

years of study and prayer, Ron and Caitlin were finally convinced. They chose the Central Visalia Bilingual Seventh-day Adventist Church as their new church home.

“Our baptism was just amazing,” Caitlin says. “The week before, we both felt an inner struggle and a lot of oppression from the devil, but we had made up our minds. Our pastor, Justin Aguilar, is a wonderful example of the love of Christ, and it was such an honor to have him baptize us. Ours is a bilingual church, and many of our members don’t understand or speak very much English. But even though I don’t speak Spanish yet, I can truly feel their love.”

Ron agrees. “I am quite happy to be serving the Lord in my church by being involved in our prayer group, in Mark Finley’s Discovery ’08 series, and other church activities,” he says.

Pastor Aguilar is thankful for their dedication to the Lord, too. “Ron and Caitlin’s willingness to be part of our outreach activities tells me that they really love their Lord Jesus Christ. Recently we started a satellite evangelistic campaign, and they promptly became part of the team. Their past experience has touched my heart, and I’m so thankful to God to have had the privilege of baptizing them.”

In addition to their evangelistic outreach, they’ve also become involved in something that is dear to their hearts. “We’ve gotten involved in a new outreach ministry to the homeless,” Caitlin says. “It’s something we’re

passionate about because we can relate to them. Every third Sabbath of each month we take our church potluck meal to the park so we can share it with the homeless, and it’s so exciting!”

In Matthew 7:15, 16 Jesus warned, “Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep’s clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. You will know them by their fruits.” As we enter the closing moments of time, more and more false prophets will appear with messages that mix truth with error. The only way we can avoid being swept away by the winds of false doctrine is to know the Word of God ourselves.

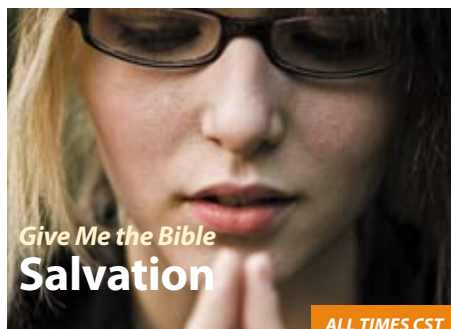

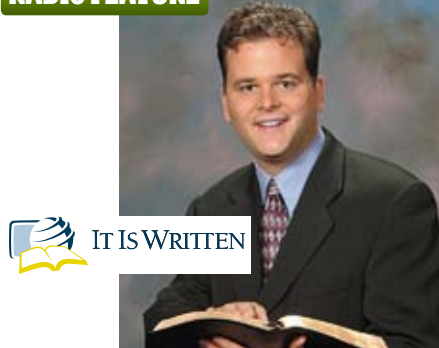

# Beef-Like Egg Rolls

밀고기 만두

## WALNUT GLUTEN FILLING

- ¾ c. walnuts
- 1 c. water
- 1½ c. gluten flour
- 2 Tbsp. whole wheat flour
- ½ tsp. sea salt
- ½ tsp. onion powder
- ½ tsp. garlic powder

## BROTH

- 5 c. water
- ¼ c. soy sauce or 1½ Tbsp. soy sauce powder
- ½ tsp. sea salt
- ¾ tsp. onion powder
- ¾ tsp. garlic powder
- 2 Tbsp. yeast flakes

Combine ingredients to make the broth and bring to a boil. Blend walnuts and water on high until creamy. Mix remaining ingredients in a large bowl. Pour blended walnuts into the dry mixture. Mix quickly and knead thoroughly. Divide dough in half and shape into two long rolls. Cut into ½-inch slices and drop into boiling broth. Simmer for 30 minutes. Gluten freezes well and can be used as a beef substitute.

## EGG ROLLS

- 2 c. ground Walnut Gluten (see recipe above)
- 2 green onions, chopped
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 1 tsp. unfermented soy sauce
- 1 Tbsp. nutritional yeast flakes
- ½ tsp. paprika
- 1 pkg. egg roll wrappers

Mix all ingredients except egg roll wrappers. Wet the edge of a wrapper with water. Place 1 or 2 teaspoons of the mixture into the middle of the wrapper. Fold in half and seal tightly. Fry on both sides until golden, or steam for 10 minutes.

During my interview, though, one of the managers said, "Carolina, you should know that all our cashiers work on Fridays and Saturdays."

My aunt looked at me, and then back to the manager. "Can you please make an exception?" she asked.

"No, I'm sorry," the manager insisted. "We need all our cashiers to work weekends because those are the busiest."

I'd learned that the Sabbath is holy, and that by respecting it I was honoring God. So I thanked the manager and told my aunt everything would be okay. I desperately needed the job, but I wouldn't violate God's Law.

Not even a minute passed before another manager said, "It's true, we need cashiers to

work weekends, but we also have sales floor associate positions that won't conflict with your Sabbaths."

There was only one catch—my salary would be lower. But all I thought was, *Praise the Lord! I don't care about the salary, as long as it covers my expenses!* What was important was to honor God.

During my first day of training I noticed my trainer didn't wear jewelry, and she ate vegetarian food for lunch. She turned out to be a Seventh-day Adventist!

# SIGNS IN THE SKY

Among the final words of His disciples, Jesus said of the last days, “after that tribulation, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars of heaven will fall, and the powers in the

recorded in the Christian world till that time, with an estimated 8.7 magnitude. The seaside city of Lisbon, Portugal, was near the epicenter off shore, and was almost totally destroyed. For many people attending mass that All Saints Day, and others who sought shelter there, their immense churches became their tombs. The quake was followed by a tsunami over 60 feet tall, and by fires. An estimated 40,000–100,000 people died, and the shock wave was felt as far as Greenland, the West Indies, Finland, and North Africa.

Twenty-five years later, on May 19, 1780, another sign was fulfilled. New England’s Dark Day was observed from Maine down to New Jersey, and as far west as Albany, New York. The sky was so dark at noon that candles were needed to perform common household chores, and many businesses closed.

“In many homes [at midday] candles flickered in windows, birds were silent and disappeared, and fowl retired to their roosts. To many members of the

legislature, devout Puritans as they were, it appeared that the promised Day of Judgment was at hand.”<sup>1</sup>

The darkness continued for some time, then later, into the night, the moon appeared, first appearing red as blood!

Shortly after these events, on November 13, 1833, there was a remarkable falling of the stars. The whole sky across the United States seemed ablaze with falling meteors—as many as 100,000–240,000 per hour! An author wrote, “No philosopher or scholar has told or recorded an event, I suppose, like that of yesterday morning. A prophet eighteen hundred years ago [Jesus] foretold it exactly, if we will be at the trouble of understanding stars falling to mean falling stars.”<sup>2</sup>

When these events happened, many believed them to be supernatural, while others pointed to various natural causes. In more recent years, people have explained all of these events scientifically—an earthquake caused by tectonic motion, a darkness caused by Canadian forest fires, a meteor shower

heavens will be shaken.” Mark 13:24–25.

The apostle Peter, quoting the prophet Joel, declared, “The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the coming of the great and awesome day of the Lord.” Acts 2:20.

The apostle John described the same signs preceding the Second Coming: “There was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became like blood. And the stars of heaven fell to the earth.” Revelation 6:12–13.

On November 1, 1755, Europe and adjacent lands were rocked by the strongest earthquake

caused by a cycle of the Leonid meteors. Yet they were extraordinary events in their day, and they awakened the people of America, and others around the world, to study Bible prophecy. In other words, the prophecies concerning these events did exactly what they were intended to do—they motivated people to study God’s Word. And when they studied, many found much more abundant and startling evidence that the end of days was at hand. ■

# GOD'S BUILDING PLANS

As Danny Shelton began to see God work miracle after miracle at just the right time, and with just the right amount of money, his faith soared. On Friday nights and Sabbath afternoons, the little group of family and church members gathered at the 3ABN building site to pray and sing, "We Are Standing on Holy Ground."

sense were not the same thing, and so he enlarged his plans to 50 by 90 feet.

Finally, as he and his brother Kenny walked out on to the land to stake out the building, God laid out His plans in Danny's heart—at least as much of it as his finite faith could handle at that time.

Danny put a stake in one corner of God's holy ground, and as Kenny held the tape measure, he started walking in the opposite direction—going well past the ninety feet he intended!

"Do you think this is big enough?" he called back.

"It looks fine to me," Kenny answered.

But God was saying, "Go a little farther son; go on, use your faith, and not your common sense."

Danny kept walking—almost to the end of the tape! Finally he stopped at 150 feet. "What do you think about making it this big?" he called back.

"Okay," Kenny hollered.

As Danny pounded the stake, I believe God smiled.

Those were hopeful days. They had so little—and needed so much. Nevertheless, like explorers, their sights were on their goal, instead of the tremendous hurdles that lay before them. And they kept moving forward.

The group had no idea how large a building to construct, so Danny started out with plans to build a small, 40 by 70 foot building. But this was where he learned that faith and common

They did the same thing to determine the width of the building, ending up with a 60 by 150 foot building. If they built most of it in two stories, there would be a total of about 16,000 square feet. It looked really big to Danny as he looked at those stakes in the middle of an empty field. In fact, he'd never built anything that big—especially without a penny to do it!

In those days, I was sure that none of them had any inkling of the magnitude of the work they were starting. When I looked at the building stakes for the first time, my only comment was, "It's not nearly big enough! Why are you building such a little building?"

Within a few years, my prediction came true. By 1994, 3ABN began building a new office and production facility that would be three times larger than the original, and when it was completed in 1996 it became 3ABN's major Production Center and the network's world headquarters.

The original Uplink Build-

ing, with one production studio, was used only as the Master Control facility, but later it housed the offices and production equipment for 3ABN Radio Network.

3ABN now has a state-of-the-art Sound Center, as well as a large Call Center. In 2003 Master Control was moved to 3ABN's headquarters, the Production Center, as well. Then, a new 1,500-seat Worship Center was built across from the new Thompsonville Christian School and gymnasium. And, oh yes, let's not forget the new production studio for 3ABN's *Kids' Time* programs, or the planned January 2009 *SonBeam Channel* launch. As you can see, the construction hasn't stopped as 3ABN continues to grow, following God's building plans. When we follow God's building plans, we can never build big enough, because God has a *world* vision.

Danny may have only had a tape measure in his hand when he walked across that first plot of land, but he had God's vision in his heart. ■

# Slow to Wrath

**D**ale Carnegie, in his famous book, *How to Make Friends and Influence People*, tells the story of a wealthy businessman in Spokane, Washington, who asked one of his employees to bring him a cup of coffee. The employee tripped and fell, spilling hot coffee on the man's lap, burning his hands, and leaving spots on his white carpet. The boss flew into a rage of anger, picked up a knife, and ran after the employee trying to kill him—right after which he had a heart attack and died. “The fact is that anger kills,” he writes.

The word *anger* occurs in the Bible 455 times. It began in the Garden of Eden, when Cain

became enraged and killed his brother, Abel. Moses, in anger, killed a man who was mistreating a fellow Israelite. John and James asked Jesus to call down fire from heaven and burn up the inhabitants who did not respond to their preaching. But is there no appropriate reason for anger? I found some in the Scriptures.

As Moses descended from Mt. Sinai with the Ten Commandments in his arms, he saw the idolatry and immorality of the people as they danced naked before a golden calf. With holy wrath, he threw down the tables of stone that were written by the finger of God (Exodus 32).

Jesus became very angry when the Jewish leaders opposed His

curing of a man who had a withered hand (Matthew 12:9–14). Another time, when Jesus saw the secular atmosphere in the temple, He became very angry—overthrowing the money changers' tables as well as the seats of those who sold doves (Matthew 21:12–15).

So what are some examples of inappropriate anger?

Anger that results from suspiciousness—as when a person frequently misinterprets the motives of others, thinking they are being rejected or made fun of. Anger that results when selfish demands are not satisfied. Anger that results from perfectionism, as when someone makes unreasonable demands upon himself, upon God, and upon others.

I was surprised to discover that anger most frequently occurs in a family when supper is being served and both spouses are tired. Studies reveal this is when most homicides take place in the home.

Anger itself is an emotion that is neutral. It is neither right nor wrong, appropriate nor inappropriate, sinful nor holy. But negative anger is always harmful. Dr. Leo Madow, in his book, *Anger: How to Recognize and Cope With It*, mentions a litany of diseases that come as a direct result of unresolved anger, including

headaches, and circulatory, gastrointestinal, respiratory, genitourinary, and skin disorders. He also lists arthritis, disabilities of the nervous system—and suicide.

Here's what God's Word advises:

“So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath.” James 1:19.

“He who is slow to anger is better than the mighty, and he who rules his spirit than he who takes a city.” Proverbs 16:32.

“He who is slow to wrath has great understanding, but he who is impulsive exalts folly.” Proverbs 14:29.

“Be angry, and do not sin: do not let the sun go down on your wrath, nor give place to the devil.” Ephesians 4:26–27. The New English Bible reads: “If you are angry, do not allow anger to lead you to sin. Do no let the sunset find you still nursing it; leave no loophole for the devil.”

What this says to me is, *It's appropriate and sometimes necessary to become angry, but be very careful that you do not sin in the process. Dissipate your anger constructively, so that it will not control your actions.*

As Christians, we desperately need the help of God to overcome the negative emotions of anger. ■

# READY OR NOT— DTV is Here!

If you live in the United States, you have seen all sorts of announcements regarding the advent of digital TV (DTV) for many months now. If you own a new set, or if you've already purchased and installed a DTV converter box, you probably won't have to do much more. But for the millions who haven't, here are the facts:

Beginning February 18, 2009, all full-power television broadcasters will switch to digital television (DTV) signals.

If you've bought a new TV after January 1, 2007, you won't need to do anything. If you watch by cable or by satellite (DISH Network, or any satellite dish) you will not be affected.

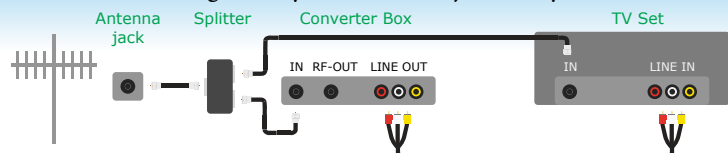
Since most of 3ABN's downlinks are low-power TV stations, they are exempt from digital broadcasting for the moment, *but we are already well into the process of changing each of those stations to DTV.*

If you want to watch any digital stations on your analog TV, you will have to buy a digital converter box, available in all electronic stores for between \$40 and \$70. You can still obtain a free \$40 coupon from the government (while supplies last) to help defray the cost at [www.dtv2009.gov](http://www.dtv2009.gov), or by calling 888-388-2009 (voice), or 877-530-2634 (TTY).

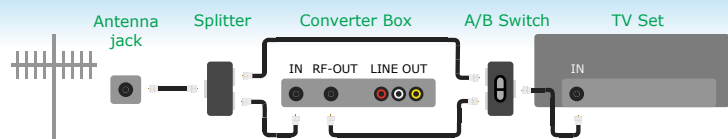
*Note: The last day to apply for a coupon is March 31, 2009.*

For converter boxes *without* analog pass-through:

**Diagram 1:** Use this diagram if you have RCA jacks on your TV.



**Diagram 2:** Use this diagram if you *don't* have RCA jacks on your TV.



If you plan on watching DTV (full-power) stations along with an analog signal from a 3ABN station, you will need a DTV converter *with analog pass-through*. If you've already purchased one that doesn't include this, you can still use it with the help of a couple of splitters (see diagrams).

According to the FCC, a special antenna is not generally needed to receive digital signals *if you have one that already gives you a good picture*. However, if your UHF signals are weak, you may need a signal booster, since most DTV stations are on the UHF band. Mountains, buildings over four stories high, or trees over 30 feet high can seriously affect your signal.
