Possible corrections for transcript

Ms. McCorkle:

Please find attached the transcript of the October 22, 2008 hearing, with comments I have included.

The main corrections would have to do with who was speaking. Lns. 9-11 of p. 15 make it clear that from ln. 17 of p. 14 through ln. 9 of p. 15 it is Mr. Joy who is speaking rather than Mr. Simpson. Thus the previous speaker before Mr. Joy must be me, from ln. 13 or ln. 17 of p. 13 through ln. 10 of p. 14. I think I must be the speaker at ln. 13 of p. 13.

Ln. 8 of p. 24 should be Mr. Joy. Ln. 23 of p. 35 was Mr. Joy, while the defendant speaking after that on p. 36 is correctly identified as me.

My sincere apologies for not identifying ourselves each time we spoke.

Here is a detail that is fairly important: \$139,000 at ln. 19 of p. 13 should be \$6,139, unless I misspoke.

The rest aren't critical, in my opinion.

Renner Publications is actually Remnant Publications (lns. 3, 9, 12, 24 of p. 16; ln. 1 of p. 31).

Ln. 24 of p. 9: Could Dashawn have been "does say"? (But "purchase" doesn't seem to fit.) I recall Mr. Simpson answering the judge's question and acknowledging that the complaint did read that way, hence my guess of "does say." But the same thought can be derived from lns. 8-9 of p. 10.

Since Judge Frazier mentioned Danny Shelton's brother at ln. 11 on p. 23, I would think that I must have mentioned Danny's brother at ln. 7 of p. 9. But that is a detail that doesn't really affect anything.
