



The influence of this body of believers spread far. Theirs was the first large-scale Protestant missionary movement. They were the first to use lay missionaries, the first to evangelize slaves, and the first to have a presence in many countries from the West Indies to Greenland, from the Baltic States to South America. Zinzendorf personally shared the gospel in places as distant as the United States, where he

preached to the Native Americans and oversaw various church affairs. In the early years, all of was financed by Zinzendorf personally.

The Pietists and Moravian Christians were the first wave of a new movement to restore the way.
