

It's not a "black/white" thing. It's the philosophy that you note, that showing people and talent at their best is "showing off instead of Praising God" instead of reasoning that we give the most praise to God when we present him our best. It is not new to 3ABN. It permeates the whole segment of Adventism which both gave birth to and grew out of the "self-supporting institutions" started by Sutherland at Madison that spread from there all across the Southeast, then across the US, and now around the world under the auspices of their international network.

What is striking at 3ABN is the way glitz and hi-tech and expensive equipment and even set design is

combined with that same old philosophy of faked humility and matching repressed appearance. And it is not necessarily a matter of choosing only those performers who "measure down" to their standards. I've seen some of the same performers who look as though they were carved from wood when they sing on 3ABN in live concert elsewhere, and discovered that they could (and did) not only exhibit facial expressions, but actually (gasp) moved about while singing--in rhythm even. Though truth to tell, it was very hard to comprehend, since the first impression images from 3ABN kept superimposing themselves on the artists so it was hard to accept them as the "real people" that they showed themselves to be in the other venue.

What I have learned from your comments is that blacks are also not immune to the stifling influence of the 3ABN stage directions. Maybe that extends to their dress code also?

But I agree in principle with your conclusion. I do think that we Adventists, black, white, tan, or purple polka-dotted, need "a TRUE representation of our church on television". But if that is to be, then it would need to show the wide diversity of people and cultures and tastes. In music, for example we would hear not only the country style of the "folk type", but the chamber music groups, the choirs, the bands, the praise worship teams, the various ethnic musical styles, and yes, the symphony orchestras as well.
